9. APPOINTMENT, OBLIGATION, INVESTITURE, INSTALLATION AND PROCLAMATION OF THE RIGHT WORSHIPFUL ASSISTANT GRAND MASTER

The Installing Officer advised that the Most Worshipful Grand Master had been pleased to appoint R.W.Bro. Prof. Denovan Keith Wilson to Assistant Grand Master. He then called upon the Grand Director of Ceremonies to summon an the escort and conduct him into Grand Lodge.

The Escort retired. The Brethren were called to order and the escort re-entered Grand Lodge accompanying R.W.Bro. Prof. Denovan Keith Wilson, Prov.G.M. of Durham, Assistant Grand Master designate.

The Installing Officer addressed R.W.Bro. Wilson as follows:

ADDRESS BY THE MOST WORSHIPFUL PRO GRAND MASTER The Most Worshipful Pro Grand Master addressed Grand Lodge as follows:

'Brethren, sadly our Grand Master cannot be with us today. It was his intention to come but he is now subject to Court mourning and I am sure you will all understand and wish to send him our very best wishes at this very sad time for his family. He has invited me to present what would have been his address to you today.'

The Most Worshipful Grand Master's Address

Brethren, I am delighted to welcome you here this afternoon and may I say how good it is to see you all. In my address to Grand Lodge in June 2018, I referred to the success of the Annual Investiture meeting which had risen to such an extent that the General Board decided that a better experience could be achieved by moving the investiture of Brethren receiving promotions in Grand Rank to the September Communication. I am delighted to say that such a move has proved to be a resounding success, and it has now become an expected characteristic of this September Communication that the Grand Temple here at Freemasons' Hall plays host to many Brethren from across the Constitution.

There can be little doubt that today's attendance is proof of the esteem in which Mark Masonry is held by all its participants and when I look around, I am heartened that so many of you have travelled great distances to be here. Brethren, our labours here today are traditionally ones of joy and celebration but this year, of course, they are tinged with sadness as the people of the United Kingdom, the Commonwealth and across the World join in mourning the death of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. Let us recall the words spoken by the King in his address to the nation just last week when he said, 'in our sorrow, let us remember and draw strength from the light of the Queen's example'.

I am now pleased to congratulate all those whom I have had the pleasure of promoting in Grand Rank this afternoon. The award of a Grand Honour, whether it is a first appointment or promotion, is not something that is given without consideration and is a positive reflection and reward for the dedicated work that each of today's recipients has carried out. I have no doubt their preferment will stimulate them still further to promote the Order at every opportunity. Brethren, change is often desirable, frequently necessary, but always inevitable. This afternoon, I have made several changes amongst the Rulers of our Order, and I am confident that the Brethren I have appointed are well qualified to lead the Order into the future. Today, Brother John Prizeman has been invested as Pro Grand Master, Brother Frank Spencer as Deputy Grand Master, and Brother Professor Denovan Wilson as Assistant Grand Master. I know that they will enjoy your support in their new roles, and I wish them every success in their future endeavours.

I would like to express my personal thanks to our retiring Pro Grand Master, Brother Raymond Smith, for his dedicated service to our Order over many years. He has always

discharged his duties in a friendly and dignified manner which has been greatly appreciated by you all, and I wish him a long and healthy retirement from active office and, together with his wife Anne, a happy future as they settle into their new home in Jersey.

In many ways today is about new beginnings. For those who have been honoured with preferment, it is the start of a new chapter in their Masonic lives. It is a time to take stock and look forward with renewed vigour; to cast off the challenges of the pandemic and to move forward positively, creating opportunities to recruit new members. But it is also a time to think about stewardship: how we can best serve our existing members and support them through the difficult times in which we live? These thoughts, Brethren, are not limited to those who have been promoted today. Indeed, they apply to us all for as we begin the new Masonic year we should think about renewal and commitment. As I reflect upon these important values, I think of the last forty years during which I have served our Order as Grand Master. Despite the many changes I have witnessed in Mark Masonry throughout the last four decades, I am proud to say that the virtues of service, commitment, resilience, ingenuity, and tolerance have remained at the heart of what we do.

During the last year, my team of Grand Officers has had a particularly busy time. In addition to installing 12 Provincial Grand Masters, undertaking the confirmation in office of another 4, and attending 28 lodge Jubilee celebrations, they also travelled to West Yorkshire and Cumberland & Westmorland to join in their sesquicentenary celebrations. The coming year promises to be just as busy with 4 installations already planned as well as 11 lodge Jubilees and 2 Provincial sesquicentenaries. And in November, we will see the constitution of the Mark District of Romania.

Brethren, we are fortunate today to have the support of deputations from other Grand Lodges and I should like to welcome them all by name. I would ask that you refrain from spontaneous applause until I have come to the end of what is quite an extensive list:

From the Grand Lodge of Mark Master Masons of Finland, R.W.Bro. Kimmo Hellgrén, Grand Secretary; from the Grand Loge de Marque de France Réunie, M.W.Bro. Dominique Paquet, Grand Master, accompanied by R.W.Bro. Daniel Fontanili, Assistant Grand Master; from the Grand Lodge of Mark Master Masons of Estonia, M.W.Bro. Kalle Küttis, Grand Master; from the Grand Lodge of Mark Master Masons of Ivory Coast, M.W.Bro. Alain Donwahi, Grand Master, accompanied by Bro. Cheick Sanogo; from the Grand Lodge of Mark Master of Espirito Santo, R.W.Bro. Jorge Dos Santos, Assistant Grand Master; and from the Grande Loge des Maitres Macons de Marque de Bénin, M.W.Bro. Dominique Doyen, Honorary Grand Master.

And from our own Constitution with their various deputations, we are delighted to welcome no less than 45 Provincial and District Grand Masters and one Grand Inspector.

I would like to conclude our welcome by acknowledging the support of the Grand Masters of the Orders administered from Mark Masons' Hall, as well as the support of R.W.Bro. Michael Herbert, P.Dep.G.M., and R.W.Bro. Keith Emmerson, P.Dep.G.M. Let us now welcome our distinguished visitors in our usual manner.

At the start of my address, I spoke about new beginnings and tomorrow the United Grand Lodge of England will open a new chapter in its history with the appointment of new Rulers. On your behalf I extend our thanks to M.W.Bro. Peter Lowndes for his contribution to Craft Freemasonry as Pro Grand Master – an office he has held since 2009. To the new Rulers, I extend our congratulations and welcome their commitment to a closer working relationship with the Orders administered from Mark Masons' Hall.

Brethren, today has been a special day and somewhat longer than usual. I am sure that you are all looking forward to the refreshment that follows so I will simply close my remarks by placing on record my thanks to the Grand Secretary and his staff for the behind-thescenes work that makes a day like this happen, and to the Grand Director of Ceremonies and his team for the excellence of the ceremonial we have witnessed today. I wish you all a very happy and successful year in which to further the traditions of our beautiful Order, and I hope that you all have a very pleasant afternoon. May God bless you all.
